Wandsworth Council are pushing forward with a scheme for a new cycle and pedestrian bridge from **Nine Elms** to **Pimlico Gardens**.

Westminster City Council are objecting to this project as are many residents of Pimlico.

WHY YOU SHOULD SAY **NO**

- The projected 18,000 pedestrians and cyclists a day will cause **extensive traffic jams** on Grosvenor Road as they try to cross this already very busy road.
- Pimlico Underground station will become even **more congested** during peak hours.
- St George's Square Garden and Dog Park will become **overcrowded** and access dangerous for kids in buggies and for the elderly.
- Pimlico Gardens – the only green public Square in London to overlook the Thames – will be **ruined** by this development.
- There is no 'destination' in Pimlico, and the quiet residential nature of St George's Square will be **destroyed** with parked cars, pedestrians and cyclists.

With Vauxhall and Chelsea Bridges and Cycle Superhighway CS5 there will already be ample provision for cyclists and pedestrians. **There is no need for another crossing.**
