NOTIFICATION OF FILMING **St George's Drive, Pimlico, SW1V** **Sunday 30th April 1600Hrs - 2359Hrs**

12th April 2017

Dear Sir / Madam

As I hope you are now aware, **'The Crown'** intend to film scenes for season 2 on St George's Drive on the evening of **Sunday 30th April 2017**.

The scenes we propose to film on this day involve vintage action vehicles travelling down St George's Drive. Due to the nature of our filming, which will include camera rigs on these vehicles and lighting cranes, we have applied for a Temporary Traffic Order to allow us to close the road between Warwick way and Gloucester Street to all traffic for the duration of our filming period between the hours of **1600Hrs – 2359Hrs**. Pedestrian access to homes and businesses will be maintained throughout although during filming periods there may be a short delay of 1 to 2 minutes. Filming Hours are still to be finalised and I will inform you as soon as these are confirmed.

We have requested the suspension of a number of resident bays in the area to allow for filming without modern vehicles in the background and to park essential film vehicles. I have attached a map overleaf with the bays we would like to suspend. We are in the process of arranging alternative parking for resident cars unable to find parking in the local area at the Q Park on Warwick way. This parking will have 24 hour security provided by the film company.

I have arranged a meeting space in the **Vestry Hall, St Gabriel's Church** to allow for any residents with queries, questions or concerns to meet with me. This will be available from **2000hrs to 2100hrs on Thursday 20th April**. I look forward to meeting as many of you as possible.

We are working closely with Westminster City Promotions, Events & Filming team and are liaising with and making a sizeable donation to the Residents Associations that cover the area we are intending to use.
